

Color Board Process

Color boards <u>must</u> be submitted with your final plans. Final plans will not be processed until we have received your color board. Please drop off your clearly labeled color board at my desk in the DRC office.

- Each color board should have the following clearly labeled
 - o home site number
 - o owner name
 - o builder name
 - o physical address (if available)
- A complete color board is the best way to expedite its approval. Ensure your color boards are complete and clearly labeled. Each color board must have:
 - o Physical, stained samples of all siding and trim materials
 - o Physical sample of stone
 - o Physical sample of roofing material
 - O Physical sample of window material and color
 - o Cut sheet/photo of exterior doors, garage doors, and lighting fixtures
 - A legend and spec sheet with complete product information
- Please ensure all samples are securely attached to your color board so we can keep your materials together.
 - O Color boards don't need to be massive a compact, well organized and labeled color board works best.

- After receiving a complete color board, the Design Review committee will review your materials and feedback will be given, as applicable.
- When materials have been approved, you will receive an Approval Letter, but you still need to **schedule your onsite mock-up during the framing stage** for final approval.
