



*Dear Suncadia and Tumble Creek Owners:*

*Waste Management has informed us that they are no longer able to pick up single-stream (mixed) recycling from our community. This change is effective immediately, and was completely unexpected. The reason for discontinuing services appears to be regulatory in nature, but Waste Management has not been forthcoming with the details. Once we have an understanding of the nature of this regulatory issue, we can work to restore this service or attempt to provide an alternative.*

**You will see the following changes this week:**

- The green recycle dumpsters at the Community Associations office and the Tumble Creek turf care yard will not be emptied this week and will be removed as soon as possible by WM.
- Blue recycle containers at Miner’s Camp, Talisman, Trailhead, and the Tumble Creek Cabins will be removed. We will monitor these areas and increase garbage pickups if needed.

**Upper County Transfer Station Recycling Option:**

There is a recycling collection point at the Transfer Station on State Route 903, near the elementary school.
